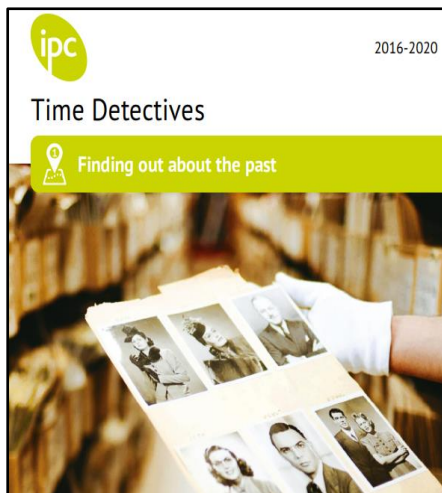

Time Detectives

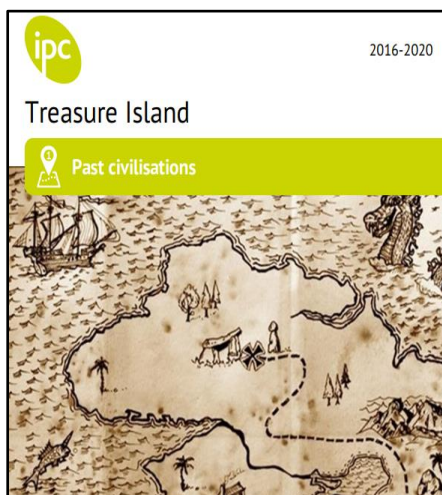

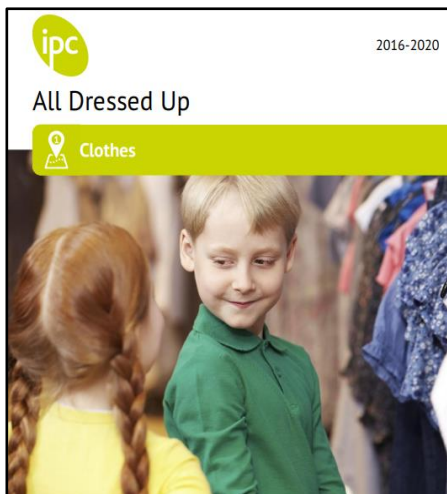


Spring 1 & Spring 2

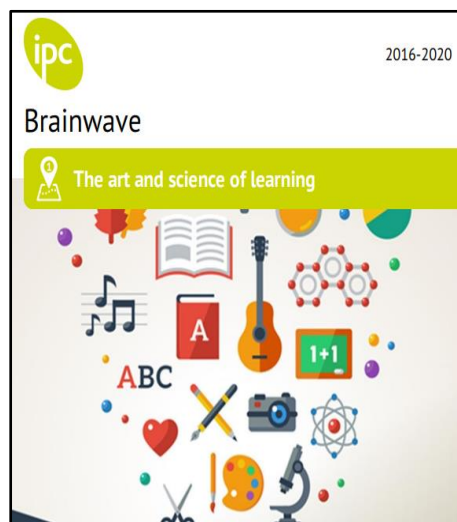


Summer 2

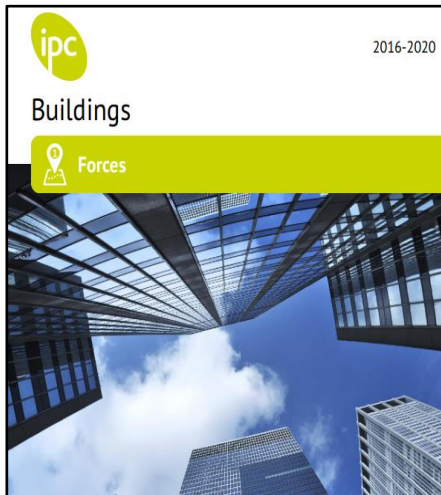


Autumn 1

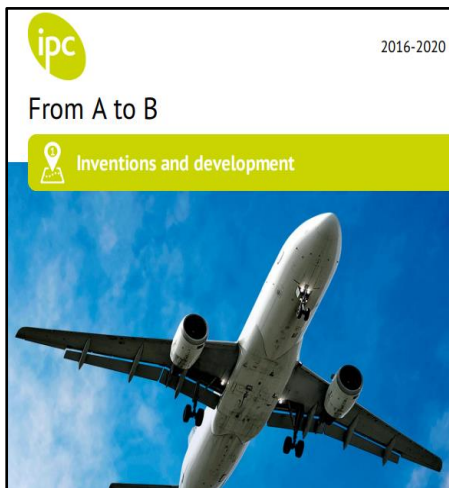

Buildings

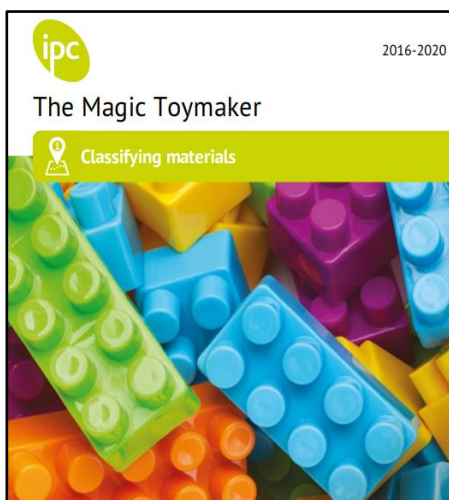
