

EYFS Homework Menu Autumn 2



Compulsory - WALT: Write our name accurately

Practise writing your name every day for 5 minutes.

Try to use a capital letter for the first letter and lower case for the rest. (This does not need to be recorded in homework books.) Please practise the phonics sounds that we have learnt so far using our weekly phonics sheets.

Completed on:

English - WALT to use initial sounds

Choose an initial sound that we have learned so far (s, a, t, p, i, n, m, d, g, o, c) and find as many objects around the house that start with that sound. Draw, write down or take a photo of the objects you find.

Challenge: can you find any of these sounds at the end of words?

Maths – WALT count to 20 and beyond

Choose an object, toy or food item in your house and count how many of them you have. You can record this by drawing or writing the number.

Challenge: Choose 2 different objects and count how many you have of each. Which one do you have the most/least of?

<u>Science – WALT recognise change in the</u> environment

Make a list of all the signs you can see outside to tell you that we are in autumn. You can choose how you'd like to share your findings.

Challenge: what happens in other seasons?

Art - WALT: practice our drawing and layout skills.

Make a bright and cheerful card for a birthday celebration. Fold a sheet of A4 paper and create a design for the front. Think about how you lay it out and colour it in fully without leaving too much blank white space.

Experience -

WALT understand different celebrations and festivals

Choose a celebration this half term and make a special treat with an adult. For example, Christmas gingerbread men, a birthday cake, a craft fireworks display, a collage menorah for Hanukah etc.

English – WALT discuss stories that we have read

Share a favourite story with an adult. Draw a picture from the story and explain why it is your favourite. This can be done verbally or written down.

Challenge: Does it remind you of any other stories you have read? Why?

Maths - WALT identify 2D shapes in real life

Go on a 2D 'shape hunt' in your house or in a different location. How many squares can you find? How many circles? How many triangles? Can you find any other 2D shapes? You can record this by taking photographs or writing or drawing the shapes.

PSHE - WALT get dressed independently.

Practise getting ready for school by yourself. Can you do your buttons? Can you turn your clothes the right way round?

Challenge: Time yourself getting dressed, how quickly can you do it? Do you get faster each time?

PE - WALT move in different ways.

Practise different ways of moving e.g. hopping, skipping, side-stepping etc. Can you show control when moving in different ways?
