History Compulsory (complete by 12/02/25)

WALT: consider the life of a Roman soldier

Draw a Roman soldier and label all of his equipment.

Use key historical words.

Write a sentence describing how this is different than a soldier's equipment today.

Would you prefer to be a soldier in Roman times or today?

Experience

WALT: explore your local area

Go on a walk around your local area. Can you find any evidence of Roman Britain? Take a picture or create a drawing of what you find and write a short paragraph about your findings.

Challenge:

-How has this effected/helped our everyday life?

-Why was it built?

-How do you think they came up with this idea?

English

WALT: explore someone else's perspective

Consider a Midsummer Night's Dream. Then, write a paragraph from the mischievous elf Puck's perspective when he turns Bottom into a donkey.

Use the figurative language such as adverbs and similes.

Use sophisticated conjunctions.

Use cultural references.

Compulsory (complete by 29/01/25)

Create your own scene based in another culture. You can create this any way you like: through drawing, collage, sculpture, etc. Make sure you give it a name.

Use adjectives to describe it.

Use emotive language to describe it.

Maths

WALT: understand how to use co-ordinates

Create your own version of Battleships. Use grid paper to create your own version of the game. You can use different battleships, aircraft carriers and submarines along with missile strikes.

Record the co-ordinates of the ships.

Records the co-ordinates of the hits and misses.

Can you do this on a four quadrant grid?

WALT: use search engines effectively

We are learning to use search engines effectively. Can you search safely online to create your own PowerPoint/Poster/Publisher document about the Ancient Greeks & Romans.

Challenge: Can you explain why the information is reliable and why you used it?

PE

WALT: understand how an invasion game works

Create your own invasion game. Remember invasion games include defenders and attackers- where the aim is to go into another team's territory (area) and score points or a goal. Examples of invasion games include, hockey, football and netball. Remember to explain the rules of your game.

Draw a picture of your game, give it a name and describe how you score points.

Draw a picture, name your game and write a list of instructions.

Art

WALT: use art to convey a message
