Compulsory - WALT: explore how traditions vary in different countries

This term our topic is 'Different Places, Similar Lives'. For your homework, we would like you to create a poster that explores the similarities and differences between a traditional holiday in different parts of the world.

French – WALT: describe a family member in French

In our French this term we will be focusing on family. For your homework we would like you to pick a member of your family, draw them and describe them.

How old are they?

Write a travel advert for a destination of your choice. Describe the setting using a range of descriptive techniques! Think about what visitors would be able to see, hear, smell, touch and taste whilst they are in this exciting place!

Maths – WALT: create multiplication word problems

It is important to keep practising your times tables! Please create word questions about the different times tables that you know. e.g. I went to the shop and bought 6 bags of 4 bananas. How many bananas did I buy in total?

Focus on your 4 and 6 times tables.

Focus on your 7 and 8 times tables.

Focus on your 9 and 12 times tables.

TTRS - WALT: apply understanding of multiplication

Log in to Times Table Rock Stars and complete 2 sound checks every week.

Remember to practise the times tables that you struggle with, not just the ones that you find easy!

RE – WALT: explain experiences on our life journey.

Many people believe that life is a journey and different experiences mark this. Think of an experience you have had in your life and why it is important. Present this any way you like.

Challenge: Ask a family member for their significant experience and compare them, how is it similar and different?

Science – WALT: investigate how homes differ due to climates around the world.

Pick two countries (from different continents) and compare the features of the homes in those places. You may wish to think about the materials the houses are made of, the main energy supply and the number of windows.

Challenge: Draw the homes and label the features.

PE – WALT: investigate sporting rules

Spend an hour doing your favourite sporting activity!

Take a photo or draw a picture of you doing the sport. Then, write a paragraph about why it is your favourite sport!
Challenge: Describe the effect the sport has on your body, which muscles are you using etc.

Art - WALT: practise our detailed drawing skills

Truck drivers in India like to decorate their trucks with beautiful colours and patterns that personalises their truck and reflect the individuals' interests and beliefs. If you had your own truck, how would you decorate it and how would it be distinctive? Use pattern, shape and colour in your work.
