Dear Parents/carers,

We hope you had a fun and relaxing February half term break! This term we exploring our new topic of '**Different Places, Similar Lives**'. This will be a geography and history-based topic and so we will be learning about the similarities and differences between how people lead their lives in different countries throughout the world.

We will be taking part in an exciting VR workshop on the Tuesday 3rd March 2026. Our VR workshop will be on the topic of Aboriginal Australia. The children will be learning about real dances, songs and storytelling captured in stunning 360° footage, exploring the deep history of the land and through fun and engaging games, learn about local flora and fauna.

In Maths, we'll be:

- Learning about fractions.
- Converting improper fractions into mixed numbers, and vice versa.
- Adding and subtracting fractions.
- Learning about decimals.

In English, we'll be:

- Exploring the features of, and then writing our own, persuasive adverts.
- Writing explanatory texts, using conjunctions and adverbs to express time and cause.
- Considering the structure of an adventure story, incorporating dialogue to convey character and develop the narrative.

In Geography we'll be:

- Interpreting maps of familiar and unfamiliar places, including digital maps.
- Describing geographical features of our locality and continent.
- Understanding how people's quality of life is impacted by local geographical features.

In History we'll be:

- Selecting and recording relevant information including multiple sources.
- Suggesting reasons for particular events and changes.
- Describing results and consequences of historical events.

In Art, we'll be:

- Looking at transport in various countries.
- Using modelling and testing to explore parts of a design.
- Producing a final design proposal identifying appropriate materials to demonstrate our ideas.

In Computing we'll be:

- Explaining that data gathered over time can be used to answer questions.
- Using a digital device to collect data automatically.
- Identifying the data needed to answer questions.

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In French we'll be:

- Learning how to say the names of family members fluently.
- Asking people if they have siblings.
- Describing and stating the ages of family members.

In Music we'll be:

- Composing our own theme and variations.
- Learning how to read music notation.
- Exploring Classical music and the composers within that era.
- Creating ways in which we can develop a simple, musical idea.

In PE we'll be:

- Exploring dances from different cultures.
- Creating sequences through repetition of movement.
- Understanding different movement skills.

All of the work we are going to do has been written to help your child reach the learning goals. Children will be reading, researching, writing, illustrating, working on their own and working in groups. We will be checking to see how well your child has learned through particular activities and asking children to explain their work.

We already know the interest you take in your child's work. If you can, please discuss with your child the work they have done as the term progresses and let them teach you.
