Science Compulsory (completed by 25.03.26)

WALT: understand plant reproduction

Research how plants reproduce. What parts of plants are involved in reproduction? Are there differences in different species of plants? What is the difference between sexual and asexual reproduction in plants?

Create a botanical drawing that shows all the parts of the plant you've chosen to draw. Label each part using scientific vocabulary (stigma, stamen, petal, stem).

Include a caption of your drawing that explains whether it reproduces sexually or asexually.

Write a paragraph that explains what you've learned from your research about plant reproduction underneath your labelled drawing.
