Dear Parents/Carers,

In Year 6, over the next 6 weeks, we will be following a unit of work on a theme that focuses on 'Fairgrounds'. This unit of work is part of the International Primary Curriculum. Each unit of work is based around specific targets derived from the learning goals for one or more of the subjects. During this unit we will be focusing on Science, Technology, History and International.

In English, we'll be:

- Revising key writing skills: Vocabulary, conjunctions, openers and punctuation
- Creating news reports using a range of techniques to captivate the reader
- Creating poems that create images and explore vocabulary
- Writing first person stories with a moral
- Exploring discursive writing and speeches

In Maths, we'll be:

- Exploring the properties of 2D and 3D shapes
- Revising the different types of angles and calculating missing angles in a right angle, straight line, whole turn and a range of shapes
- Using strategies to help us calculate time intervals and interpret a timetable
- Exploring a range of projects which involve problems solving and reasoning

In Art, we'll be learning about our topic 'Create from Waste':

- Exploring artists that use re-cycling in their work
- Understand the importance of creating as part of a group
- Understanding that art can convey important global messages

In Science, we'll be:

- Exploring Newtons Law of Motion
- Creating hypotheses to support our scientific conclusions
- Considering forces and the power and effects that they have
- Exploring the properties of magnets

In Music, we'll be learning about:

- Learning to use diction create tongue twisters and rhythmic words.
- Exploring music technology to create different rhythmic patterns.
- Using our chordal knowledge to create a boom whacker chord sequence as a team.

In Design, Technology and Innovation, we'll be learning about:

- How we can use modelling and testing to improve design
- What is important when creating a design
- Which tools are appropriate for different uses and techniques

In RE, we'll be:

- Considering what matters most to Christians and Humanists
- Exploring a 'code for living' and discussing how each person is influenced by their religion
- Exploring similarities and differences between Christian and Humanist values

In PE, we'll be:

- Developing our understanding of how to improve our fitness
- Sequencing and grading sequences in our gymnastics routines
- To be able to hold different poses while also jumping of and balancing on different objects.

In computing, our topic is 'Programming A - Variables in games' where we will learn:

- To define a 'variable' as something that is changeable
- To explain why a variable is used in a program
- To choose how to improve a game by using variables
- To design a project that builds on a given example
- To use my design to create a project
- To evaluate my project

Homework

For the remainder of the year the children in Year 6 will be expected to access SATS Bootcamp for their homework, in addition to their weekly spelling sheets. Please encourage children to watch the support videos and practice a range of questions.

- Homework will be set on a Friday and due in on the following Wednesday
- Your child's reading record should be in school every day
- Children need to be reading at least three times a week and a comment recorded into their reading record every time they read.
